## REQUEST FOR COMMENTS ON THE DRAFT 2023 BUDGET POLICY STATEMENT FOR THE MTEF FY 2023/24 – 2025/26 BUDGET

Pursuant to Section 25 of the Public Finance Management (PFM) Act, 2012, The National Treasury is required to seek and take into account the views of stakeholders and the public in preparing the Budget Policy Statement (BPS) before submission to Cabinet for approval and subsequent submission to Parliament. In particular, Section 25 of PFM Act requires the National Treasury to seek views of the following:

- i. The Commission on Revenue Allocation;
- ii. County Governments;
- iii. Controller of Budget;
- iv. The Parliamentary Service Commission;
- v. The Judicial Service Commission;
- vi. The Public; and
- vii. Any other interested persons or groups.

We have now prepared the Draft 2023 Budget Policy Statement (BPS) for the MTEF FY 2023/24 - 2025/26 Budget which is available at the National Treasury website (www.treasury.go.ke). The purpose of this Public Notice is to invite general and specific comments on the Draft 2023 Budget Policy Statement to enable finalization of the document.
