- iii. Suggestions on how to strengthen implementation of Government priority programmes under the Bottom-Up Economic Transformation Agenda (BETA) geared towards economic turnaround and inclusive growth;
- iv. Specific ways to accelerate recovery and growth of the private sector and MSMEs;
- v. How to integrate the youth and women into accelerating sustainable economic recovery;
- vi. Ways to prudently manage public resources; and
- vii. Any other budget tips or suggestions.
